

Staff are given the opportunity to learn in an for an immersive setting while providing for this valuable experience for our campers.

World-Glass Training

We provide all staff with a hands-on professional training that is based on the TEACCH approach. The training team consists of TEACCH-certified trainers, and our Camp Director Jon Blalock is a Certified TEACCH Advanced Consultant with 25 years of experience serving people with disabilities, particularly clients with ASD. Through a series of lectures, activities, and reverse-shadowing with model campers, staff are well prepared to work with clients with a variety of support needs.

Internship Opportunities

We have worked with Universities and Colleges in the past to develop internship opportunities for students in disciplines including Psychology, Recreation Therapy, and Occupational Therapy. Additionally, our setting may be appropriate for disciplines such as Special Education, Speech Therapy, Social Work, and other Human Service fields. Our program provides 400+ hours of client contact.
